IITU has seen impressive results in the hiring and compensation of Red Hat Academy participants compared with their fellow students.

"The employment rate for graduates who completed Red Hat Academy training is 92%, versus 82% for the rest of the student population, demonstrating their increased desirability in the job market," said Talgat Nurlybayev, Assistant Professor, IITU. "Program participants also enjoy greater earning potential with an 18% higher starting salary on average."

In addition, program graduates realize significantly more positive outcomes than candidates from similar institutions.

The university has also made progress in addressing the digital gender gap in the region, with women graduates of the Red Hat Academy program continuing to outperform their peers in terms of employment and earnings.

Looking towards the future

In a testament to the quality of instruction and the dedication of both instructors and students, IITU's program was honored as Red Hat Academy of the Year for its region. This prestigious recognition put IITU and Kazakhstan on the map as a hub for open source education.

4 Reduced onboarding time

With a turnover rate between 13% and 20%,¹ nearly 1 in 5 IT professionals are in their first year at their current organization. And the time required to bring them up to speed—which can span several months—can be very costly in terms of lost productivity and increased potential for mistakes.
